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1. HDR thesis submission process


Notification of Intent to Submit (NOI)

Thesis Format, Oral Examination opt-in, & Access restriction request


Decision point for Oral Examination in NOI eForm

1a. Thesis examination – without oral examination*






^{*} This examination process is available only to HDR candidates who commenced prior to 1 July 2024

1b. Oral Examination of HDR candidates

Now available to all ANU HDR candidates	Opt-in for candidates who commenced prior to 1 July 2024; required for candidates who commenced from 1 July 2024.
Why?	International & Go8 standard; improve candidates' examination experience.
When?	Normally within 8 weeks of submission, and within ANU business hours.
How?	Virtual; managed by Oral Examination Chair independent of supervisory panel.
Chair	Senior ANU academic with specific training; nominated by Delegated Authority. Chair training will begin in second quarter 2025.
Who participates?	Candidate, Chair, Examiners, candidate-invited Support Person (optional).
Duration & communication of results?	Max. 2 hours; informal advice to candidate after deliberation period; formal recommendation to Delegated Authority.

2. HDR thesis format changes

- A revised Procedure: Thesis Formats will replace the current <u>Procedure</u>
- The new Procedure will identify and define 4 thesis formats:
 - 1. Written thesis where either a single piece of written work, or a collection of written works, is the primary output;
 - 2. Thesis by Publication in place of the current 'Thesis by compilation';
 - Thesis by Creative Works as at present;
 - 4. Thesis by Artefacts comprising one, or a combination of, digital, printed, built material object or multimedia works.



3. Rights, Relationships and Respect in Research



- A revised online module for HDR candidates, and HDR supervisors.
- Developed by ANU Respectful Relationships Team, in support of the University's commitment to a safe and respectful workplace.
- All HDR candidates are expected to complete in first 3 months of program.
- Optional completion by HDR supervisors qualifies as a Registration Renewal Activity.
- Complements other <u>ANU Respectful Relationships resources and training</u> (which also qualify as Registration Renewal Activities).



4. HDR-related ANU Sharepoint sites

The ANU Research and Innovation Portfolio Hub hosts these HDR-related sites:

- HDR Decision makers guide
 - resources for ADHDRs, Delegated Authorities and Convenors. Useful for supervisors too
- HDR Handbook
 - the go-to guide for HDR candidates
- HDR Industry Engagement
 - supporting external engagement and career development for HDR candidates
- Confirmation of Candidature
 - research training milestone, normally 9-12 months after commencement
- iThenticate for HDR
 - a required tool to support candidates and supervisors to check for plagiarism
- Oral Examination
 - now available to all ANU HDR candidates
