E-SCOOTERS ON CAMPUS

In line with recent increase in reported electric scooters (e-scooters) related hazards from the ANU community, this is **reminder to familiarise yourself with the guidelines for operating**, and **properly securing electric scooters** (e-scooters) and other designated micro-mobility devices on campus.

E-scooters and micro-mobility devices are **restricted from being inside** any ANU facilities (residences allowed). This includes all buildings, public facilities, shops other University facilities. Parking e-scooters inside and charging unattended, pose a number of hazards including fire and electrical hazards.

Safety is a top priority at ANU for students, faculty, and staff.

What are the restrictions?

- Charging e-scooters in ANU facilities is **no longer permitted**, unless you have a written permission from your Director, Dean, or other divisional leaders.
- If you reside in ANU Residential Halls and other residential areas, you may be permitted to charge your e-scooter if the charger has been fitted with a timer.
- Use of **imported e-scooters** with non-compliant or incompatible charging systems is not permitted on ANU campuses (including residences). For example using a charger with 110V.
- E-scooters and micro-mobility devices must be secured outside University facilities at bike racks. If using e-scooters and micro-mobility devices, have a plan for properly securing it.
- E-scooters and other micro-mobility devices found inside any University facility or improperly parked in places other than bike racks may be impounded at the owner's expense.

Staff and Students are reminded to report incidents to their supervisor and/or through the FIGTREE online incident notification system.
