## PARKING OPTIONS @ANU



WHERE?	HOW MUCH?
ANU surface permit	\$449/year or \$111 for 90 days
ANU parking stations (permit)	\$2000/year or \$495 for 90 days
Pay and display (pay using bank card)	\$2.90 for 1 hour, \$6 for 2 hours, \$10.50 for 3 hours
Pay as you go (must use Cellopark app)	\$2.19/hour or \$15.70 per day
Karotini car park	\$5 for 30 mins or \$12 per day for early bird parking
