

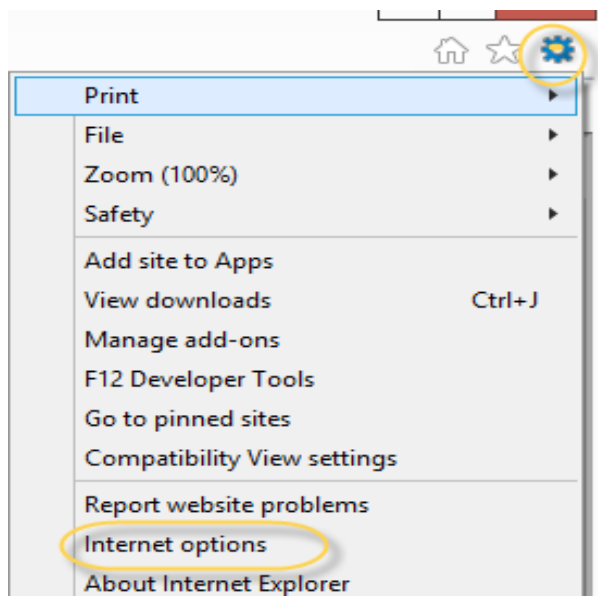
# ALLOWING POP-UP WINDOWS

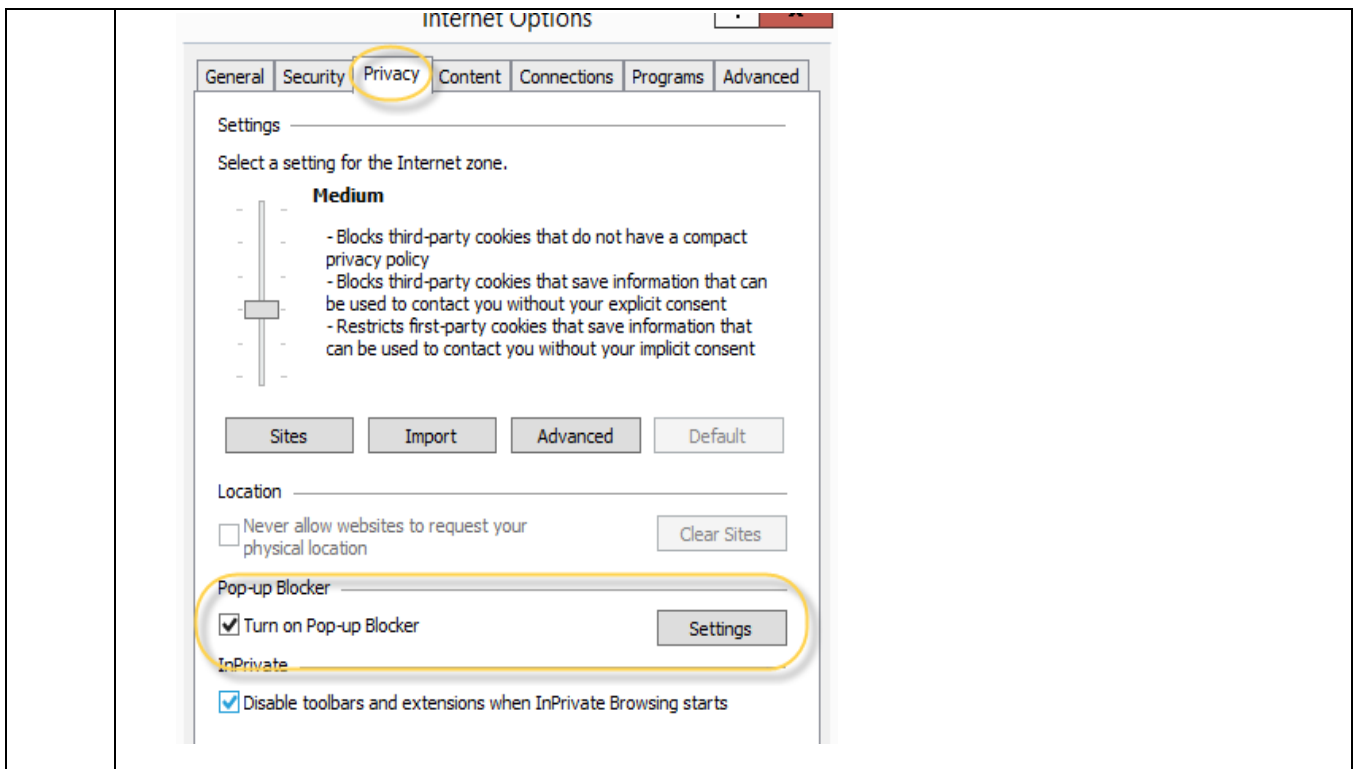
Most web browsers include a feature to block pop-up windows. While this may eliminate unwanted or bothersome pop-up windows, the feature sometimes can block wanted or useful websites.

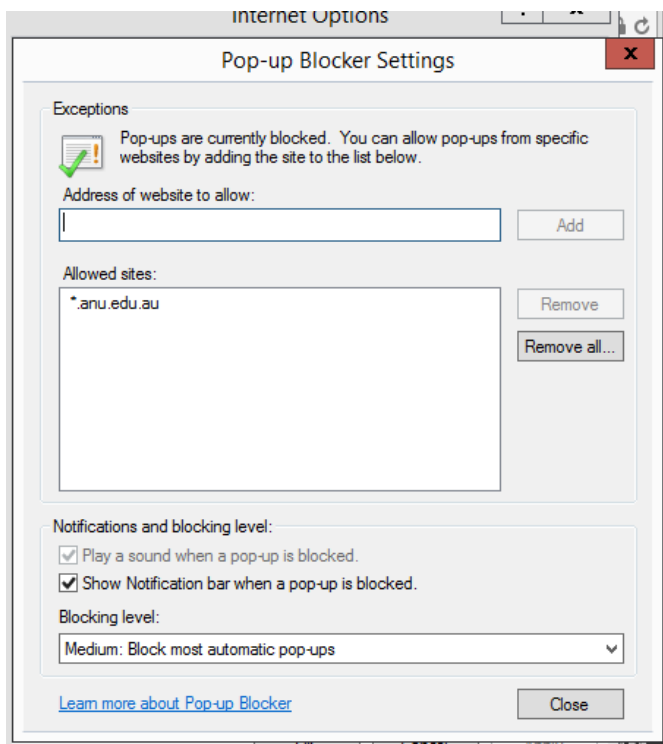
Navigate to: **Tools > Internet options > Privacy > Pop-up blocker settings**

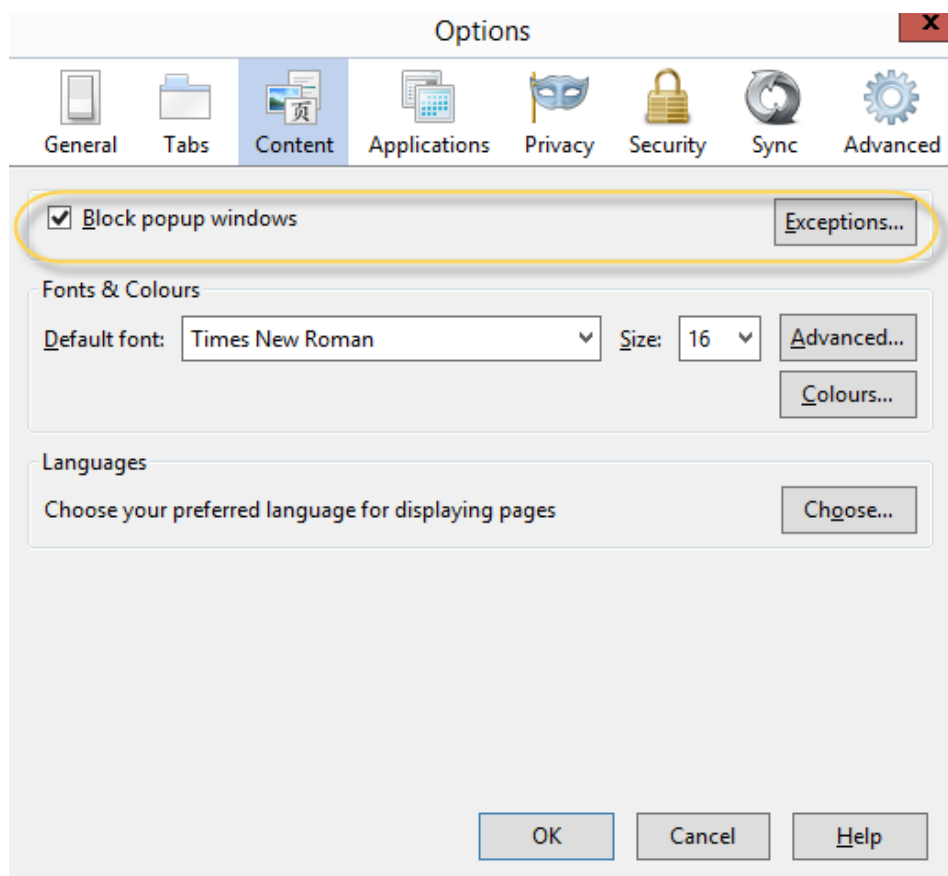
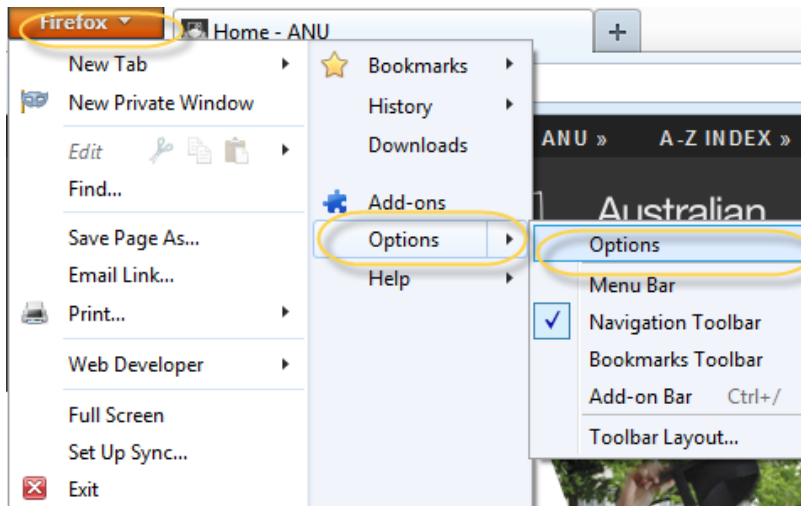
Type **\*.anu.edu.au** in the **address of website** field, **add** and then **close**



# Mozilla Firefox 24.1.1


